100 years of shaping the world

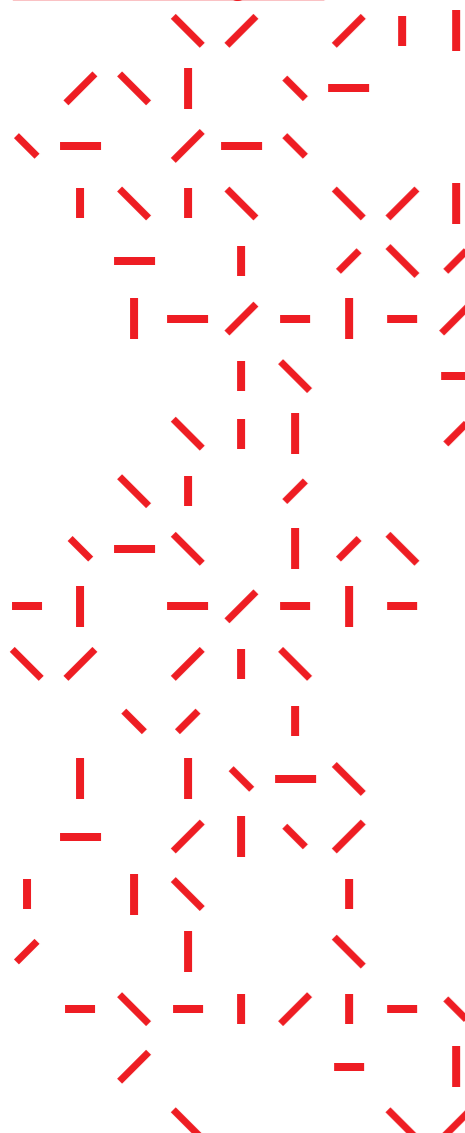
Without a doubt, De Stijl is Holland's most important contribution to twentieth century culture. What started as the name of a magazine turned into a global icon of modernity. In 2017, we will celebrate the 100th anniversary of this world-famous avant-garde art movement that was founded exactly 100 years ago. De Stijl's central question: how do you shape the new society of the future? A better, hopeful future, belief in progress, optimism, and humor: this is what characterized De Stijl.

And these are precisely the themes that today's Dutch Design – in Holland and abroad – still focuses on. Hella Jongerius, Maarten Baas, and Piet Hein Eek are just a few of the Dutch Designers who became famous far beyond the Dutch borders. In 2017, you will find De Stijl and Dutch Design throughout Holland: in Leiden, The Hague, Drachten, Eelde, Utrecht, Amersfoort, Eindhoven, Bergeijk, Breda, 's-Hertogenbosch, Tilburg, Helmond, Oisterwijk, Winterswijk, Apeldoorn, Arnhem, Harderwijk, and the National Park De Hoge Veluwe. 1917-2017: one hundred years in which the Dutch tried to (re)design the world.

The Hague

The Hague is the Mondrian city of Holland. The Gemeentemuseum Den Haag boasts the world's largest collection of works by Piet Mondrian (1872-1944) as well as the most extensive De Stijl collection. Starting on 3 June, the museum will put all of its 300 drawings and paintings on display in a huge oeuvre exhibition that represents a voyage through the work of Mondrian: from green realistic landscapes to brightly colored windmills and from cubist paintings to, of course, the Victory Boogie Woogie.

Utrecht & Amersfoort

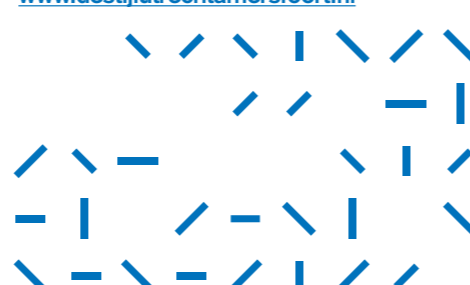
The Utrecht & Amersfoort region played an important part in the development of the De Stijl art movement. Four major De Stijl artists were born in Utrecht or Amersfoort: Theo van Doesburg (Utrecht, 1883), Bart van der Leek (Utrecht, 1876), Gerrit Rietveld (Utrecht, 1888), and Piet Mondrian (Amersfoort, 1872).

The Centraal Museum in Utrecht boasts the world's largest Rietveld collection and will put on a special exhibition showing off a lot of early work by Rietveld and some of his peers. In the fall, this museum will devote attention to 'Droog - Discover the origin of Dutch Design'. The Rietveld Schröder House is the architectural highlight of De Stijl and is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

The renovated Mondriaanhuis, where Piet Mondrian was born, will reopen its doors in Amersfoort. Kunsthal KAdE will hold a special exhibition focusing on the use of color by De Stijl artists. The Rietveld Pavilion in Amersfoort is one of Gerrit Rietveld's major late works and will be open to the public from the fall of 2017.

Both cities will also organize a special peripheral program.

North Netherlands

Color in architecture and design

A unique aspect of North Netherlands is that visitors can experience De Stijl as architecture. Visit the Van Doesburg-Rinsema House in Drachten and the former National Aviation School in Eelde (Rijksluchtvaartschool Eelde).

Drachten has strong ties with De Stijl. It is where Theo van Doesburg realized his first big commission: the color design for 16 middle class homes in 1921. One of these homes is currently being restored and will be opened in 2017 as a museum residence. Another icon is the building complex of the Rijksluchtvaartschool in Eelde, the last big work of De Stijl artist Bart van der Leek. He designed the color scheme in 1954. Eelde also possesses a number of monumental works by contemporary artists inspired by De Stijl, such as Jan van der Ploeg. Leeuwarden focuses on Dutch Design.

During the theme year, Museum Dr8888 will organize four big exhibitions revolving around De Stijl. Eelde focuses on contemporary art inspired by De Stijl, with a big design exhibition in the fall. You can also enjoy Dutch Design in Leeuwarden with ceramics and design furniture inspired by folk art.

Leiden

Leiden, 100 years of De Stijl

Leiden is the city in which De Stijl was born. It is where, in 1917, Theo van Doesburg (1883-1931) founded the magazine to which the international movement owes its name. In those years Leiden was a city resonating with art and science, where internationally renowned scientists like Albert Einstein and Paul Ehrenfest worked side by side with artists like Theo van Doesburg. With his huge commitment to De Stijl, he shaped a new world in a revolutionary manner: the world of modern life in the twentieth century. In 2017, Leiden is still an international meeting place for talent, knowledge, and innovation. Especially for 'Mondrian to Dutch Design', Leiden will be reviewing 100 years of De Stijl. In several exhibitions the city will show how today's artists are giving substance to abstract art. Discover the source of De Stijl with a varied and modern program of special exhibitions and activities.

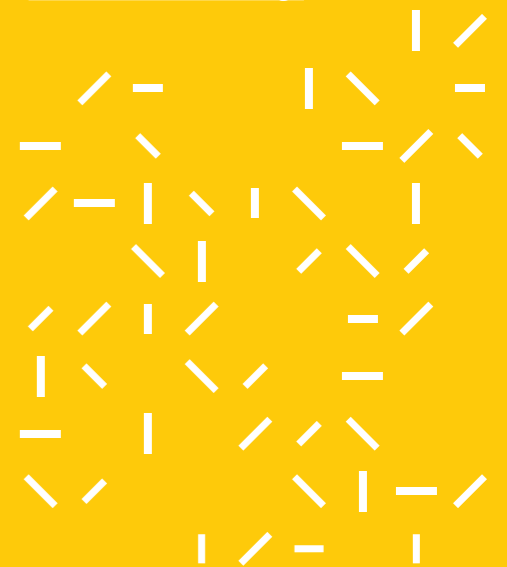

Gelderland

Gelderland has many places where you can experience De Stijl and the art that was created by the movement. The Kröller-Müller Museum is one of the treasure troves of De Stijl, with top works by Mondrian, Van Doesburg, Van der Leek, and Rietveld. In Harderwijk you can discover Vilmos Huszár, an early member of the influential art movement. And Villa Mondriaan brings you close to the artist himself. This is where Piet Mondrian lived from the age of 8 to 20, when he laid the foundation for his life as an artist. Museum Arnhem presents the Peter Alma exhibition: Pioneer of modern social art.
