2019 THE YEAR OF REMBRANDT

In 2019 it will be 350 years since Rembrandt passed away. Several cultural institutions in the Netherlands are marking this important anniversary with various activities throughout the year. During The Year of Rembrandt, the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam will present major exhibitions, events and activities dedicated to the greatest master of the Dutch Golden Age.

EXHIBITIONS

All the Rembrandts

15 February – 10 June 2019

Nowhere in the world can you find more Rembrandts than in the Rijksmuseum. And for the first time, the entire collection is on display at *All the Rembrandts*. Twenty-two paintings, sixty drawings and the 300 best examples of his 1,300 prints give a complete and versatile picture of the Netherlands' most important artist. The exhibition not only showcases his phenomenal technique and innovative applications, but also gives visitors an opportunity to know Rembrandt the man. The numerous scenes from everyday life show him in his own environment and reflect what held his interest.

During *All the Rembrandts*, a special Rembrandt Multimedia Tour is available in NL, EN, DE and FR.

The exhibition *All the Rembrandts* can only be booked by groups of Preferred Partners. Groups need a valid reservation for the main building and a reservation for a timeslot of the exhibition. These reservations can be booked separately in the Preferred Partner environment.

Rembrandt – Velázquez

11 October 2019 – 19 January 2020

In the autumn of 2019, the Rijksmuseum presents *Rembrandt-Velázquez*. A comprehensive overview of paintings by the two great masters of the 17th century from the Netherlands and Spain. Extraordinary works, rooted in realism and religion, were created in both artistic environments. Masterpieces by Velázquez, Rembrandt, Murillo, Vermeer, Zurbarán, Hals and Ribera are on display together for the first time thanks to a unique collaboration between the Museo del Prado and the Rijksmuseum. The Spanish and Dutch masterpieces will be exhibited in pairs, each of which is an extraordinary encounter where the focus is all about beauty.

For the exhibition *Rembrandt – Velázquez* it is not clear at this moment if there will be timeslots. When there is more information about this, we will communicate clearly.
